DO YOU HAVE A PRESSING NEED? REFUSE TO WORRY ABOUT THIS SITUATION. TRUST GOD COMPLETELY TO FULFILL HIS PROMISE TO MEET ALL OF YOUR NEEDS

This blog post contains an explanation of promises from God that will give you specific help with *many* problems that you may face. I believe that our Father is calling me to write these blog posts throughout the remainder of my life until He calls me home to live with Him throughout eternity in the glory of heaven. All Scripture references in this journal are from *The Amplified Bible*.

God has provided for your greatest need. "He who did not withhold or spare [even] His own Son but gave Him up for us all, will He not also with Him freely and graciously give us all [other] things?" (Romans 8:32)

God willingly sent His beloved Son to earth as a human being to provide for the greatest need that any person will ever have. God has made full provision for every person who has received Jesus Christ as his or her Savior to *live* throughout eternity with Him in the glory of heaven.

God assures you that He will meet every other need. "...God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:19)

God did not promise to meet just some of your needs or most of your needs. He has promised to "liberally supply your *every need*." If you have a need in any area of your life, meditate consistently on this magnificent promise from God. The amplification says that God will "fill to the full" your every need. How could God be more emphatic?

If Jesus Christ is your Savior, He is your Shepherd. You will not lack for anything. The palmist said, "The Lord is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me], I shall not lack." (Psalm 23:1) Jesus referred to this psalm when He said, "I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd risks and lays down His [own] life for the sheep." (John 10:11)

Your Good Shepherd laid down His life for you. In the world, sheep trust completely in their shepherd. You can trust completely in your Good Shepherd to meet every need. You "shall *not* lack."

Do you fear God and revere Him? "O fear the Lord, you His saints [revere and worship Him]! For there is no want to those who truly revere and worship Him with godly fear." (Psalm 34:9)

If you fear and revere God and worship Him continually, every area of your life is centered around Him. Your loving Father assures you that there will be “no want” in your life. God promises you that He will meet every need you have.

Your Father instructs you to seek His provision based upon specific promises from His Word. “...they who seek (inquire of and require) the Lord [by right of their need and on the authority of His Word], none of them shall “lack any beneficial thing.” (Psalm 34:10)

If you have a need and you seek the Lord based on “the authority of His Word,” you will *not* “lack any beneficial thing.” Your Father assures you that *He will meet every need* that you have. You will receive manifestation of this promise and all other promises from Him in your life in direct proportion to your faith in Him and His promises and your patience and perseverance while you wait for God’s perfect timing. (Luke 8:15 and Hebrews 6:12)

The Scripture references in this post have helped me many times over the years. I pray that they will help you to trust God to meet every need you have.
